

Four Steps to Protect Kids In Motor Vehicles



1. Infant Safety Seat

Rear Facing Only in the back seat of the car.
Birth to 20/22 pounds*

2. Infant / Toddler Convertible Car Seat

Rear Facing--birth to 30/35 pounds*
Front Facing--30 to maximum weight
for the seat.*AND a child should be
close to age 2 before he faces forward.

*Follow manufacturer's instructions

3. Booster Seat

Front facing only. For children who have
outgrown a car seat & are not tall
enough to use the vehicle seat belts.

Use from 40 pounds to about 80 pounds,*
or until the child is about 4 ft. 9 in. tall.

*Follow manufacturer's instructions

4. Vehicle Seat Belt

Use safety belts for older children who are tall enough for the seat belt
to fit correctly.
